Know Before You Go: Royalty Edition!

Parade applications must be turned in by July 13th. If your application is not received on time, you can enter the day of, but you will **not** be announced and you will be at the end of the parade. You can complete your entry at https://www.chiefjosephdays.com/grandparadeentry

Parking for all contestants and visiting royalty is in the Contest Parking Area outside of the fence of the grounds. Contestant parking is all dry camping, we do not have any hookups. You can park in our campground located just West of the rodeo grounds for \$30/night there are no hookups there either, if you have horses with you please stay along the North side near the railroad tracks. Please be considerate of all other horse trailers and try to not take up more room than you need. Please be sure to clean up after yourself and your horses. Visiting royalty will receive one ticket for each girl as well two tickets for chaperones for Saturday night after attending the Queen's Luncheon on Saturday. All visiting royalty must buy extra tickets if needed for family members. You do not need a ticket to get into the grounds but a ticket is required to get into the grandstands. You can order online through our website at https://www.chiefjosephdays.com/ or purchase them at the Main Street Rodeo office or at the gate.

The arena closes 1 hour before each rodeo performance. There is slack each day beginning at 2 pm lasting a couple of hours, you will not be able to ride in the arena at this time. There is a warm-up area behind the North Side grandstands if needed.

Check-in for all visiting royalty will be on the North End of the arena by the arena entrance beginning at 6 pm. There will be multiple signs posted to find the check-in spot. Visiting royalty can ride in the serpentine but will not be participating in run-ins unless asked by CJD.

The Harley Tucker Memorial Arena is located at 405 W. Wallowa Ave Joseph, OR 97846. As you drive into Joseph from Enterprise, turn right on W. Alder Street at the "Contestant Parking" sign and follow that road to the contestant parking area.

- No Candy or other objects can be thrown from floats or vehicles. However, you may hand out candy while walking alongside parade vehicles. This is to avoid injury, to spectators, especially children. We ask your cooperation so that everyone can enjoy the parade.
